Mr. Erik Jacobs is Co-Director of the Willard Middle School Chorus Program, serving over 500 singers across seven choirs. Under his leadership, the program has earned consistent Superior ratings at district assessments and festivals and has been recognized as a Blue Ribbon School of Musical Excellence. A frequent guest conductor and presenter, Mr. Jacobs is an active member of the Virginia Choral Directors Association and the American Choral Directors Association, where he has served in leadership roles. He is also Co-Founder and Associate Artistic Director of the South Loudoun Youth Chorale. Mr. Jacobs holds a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the Eastman School of Music.



JOHN MORRISON - Accompanist

John Morrison is an Associate Professor of Music at Fairmont State University in the Department of Humanities and has been on the Fairmont State Music faculty since 2006. He is instructor of piano, the director of choirs, and the pianist of the Collegiate Singers and Community Choir. He is an active collaborative pianist and has been the WVACDA Collegiate Honor Choir accompanist since 2015, the WV All State Children's Chorus accompanist since 2016, WV Governor's School for the Arts Vocal Accompanist (2016, 2025), and an Interlochen Arts Camp staff accompanist. John has served as the President of the West Virginia Music Teachers Association as well as in other WVMTA roles such as conference site coordinator. He received the 2022 WVMTA Distinguished Leader of the Year Award, the 2020 WVMTA Teacher of the Year Award, and was featured in the Times West Virginian in "20 People to Know in 2020." He has been an instructor of piano and violin in the Academy for the Arts at Fairmont State University since 2005. John has served as the music director and organist at the Fairmont First Presbyterian Church since 2009 where he directs the Chancel Choir and Cambridge Handbell Choir. He received a double Bachelor's Degree in Piano Performance and French and a Master's Degree in Piano Performance from WVU in 2005. His piano studies were with Dr. Marina DiPreto (Lupinacci), Dr. Peter Amstutz, and Dr. Christine Kefferstan.

William Owens (b. 1963) is a native of Gary, Indiana. He is a seasoned music educator and very active as a composer, clinician and conductor throughout the United States and Canada. His compositional style for young ensembles displays a keen, practical approach which has firmly established him as a leader in the field. Since 1993, Mr. Owens has written over 200 commissioned and published works for concert band, string orchestra and small ensemble. His music is performed and appears on required music lists nationally and abroad. Principal commissions include those from the California Band Directors Association, the Iowa Bandmasters Association, the South Plains College (TX) Department of Fine Arts, the College of Charleston (SC) and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. Several of his works including *The Blue Orchid* and *Maesong* have been recorded and analyzed in educational text by the GIA series *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band*. Other works such as *Carpathia*, *Great Wall*, *The Tahoka Galop* and *Tudor Sketches* have become staples of the young band repertoire.

William is a 1985 graduate of Chicago's VanderCook College of Music and the recipient of numerous awards and grants for composition. Professional memberships include the American Society of Composers Authors and Publishers (ASCAP), the Texas Music Educators Association (TMEA), the Association of Texas Small School Bands (ATSSB) and Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity. He is recognized as a Distinguished Alumnus by his alma mater, and a recipient of the Texas Bandmasters Association's Meritorious Achievement Award.

In January 2014, William formally retired from duty as a band director in Texas after 30 years of service. His spare time interests include sightseeing and reading, particularly motivational material and Presidential biography. A proud Chevrolet Corvette owner/enthusiast, he holds membership with Cowtown Vettes, a non-profit service organization in the Dallas/Fort area. William resides in Fort Worth, TX with his wife and best friend, Georgia.

Prior to joining the faculty at Temple, she was the Director of Bands at Cal State Fullerton where she conducted the Wind Symphony, Symphonic Winds, and taught courses in conducting and music education. She was also a Visiting Assistant Professor at SUNY Potsdam's Crane School of Music. She earned her doctor of musical arts degree from the University of Michigan, master of music degree from Northwestern University, and bachelor of music dual degree in music education and saxophone performance from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst.

Cornett taught at Essex High School in Essex Junction, Vermont from 2007-2010 where she conducted three concert bands, jazz band, and taught courses in guitar and history of rock. She was also the Director of Instrumental Music at Woodland Regional High School in Beacon Falls, Connecticut, from 2003–2005. She is published in the Teaching Music Through Performance in Band series, the CBDNA Journal, the WASBE Journal, and The Instrumentalist. Her editions of Divertimenti Nos. 2, 3, and 4 by eighteenth-century composer Vicente Martín y Soler are published by Boosey & Hawkes in the Windependence Series. She has presented sessions at The Midwest Clinic, national and regional CBDNA conferences, and numerous state conferences. Guest conducting engagements have included “The President’s Own” United States Marine Band, as well as district, region and state-level ensembles in 20 states. She is a member of the College Band Directors National Association, the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association and the National Association for Music Education.

Joey M. Martin is a musician regarded for his diverse musical interests, engaging artistry, and passionate enthusiasm for the choral art. He holds the rank of professor of music at Texas State University (TXST) and continues in his 27th year as Director of Choral Activities with additional duties as the Associate Dean for Faculty and Research in the College of Fine Arts and Communication. Dr. Martin has been recognized as a Favorite Professor at Texas State and has received several Presidential Distinction Awards for both teaching and service. During his time at TXST he has directed four of the six university vocal ensembles. Under his direction, TXST Chorale tours internationally with performances throughout much of Europe, South Africa and China and for numerous conferences including the Texas Music Educators Association, the southwest division of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), national ACDA, and the International Kodály Festival.

In addition to his work at TXST, Dr. Martin has served as the artistic director for the Alamo City Men's Chorale, chorus director for the Mid-Texas Symphony, and with Craig Hella Johnson as part of the creative team for the Victoria Bach Festival. His scholarly/creative activities span 31 of the United States and 17 countries on 6 continents including much of Europe, South Africa, Australia, New Zealand, China, Thailand, Japan, and Brazil. For 17 years he reveled in sharing the 'aloha spirit' of Hawai'i with exceptional young musicians from the mainland through concerts and enrichment activities to foster awareness and understanding of Polynesian cultures.

Commitment to service is a priority for Dr. Martin. His service in music ministry spans 36 years in positions as choir/handbell director/organist for various churches including Elk City Presbyterian Church (OK), Weatherford United Methodist Church (OK), historic First Protestant Church in New Braunfels (TX), and currently with New Braunfels Presbyterian Church. He served for 7 years as the National ACDA Repertoire and Resources Chair for College and University Choirs and currently serves on the board of directors for the Grammy award-winning choral ensemble, Conspirare. In recognition of his service, Dr. Martin was awarded the Choral Advocacy Award during the 2022 conference of TCDA.

As a pianist, he enjoys collaboration with vocal and instrumental artists in recitals having served as coach/accompanist for diverse artists including vocalists Jennie Olson, Maria Jette, Timothy Jones, Ron Ulen, Daveda Karanas, Soon Cho, Juli Wood, Richard Novak, and Cheryl Parrish as well as trio work with violist Ames Asbell and cellist Karla Hamelin.

Dr. Martin received his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in choral conducting from the University of Texas at Austin where he was recognized as the Outstanding Graduate Student while studying conducting with Craig Hella Johnson. He is a recent graduate of the Harvard School of Education Management Development Program, a member of the Fulbright specialist roster, and served as a mentor for the Texas Academic Leadership Academy. In his spare time, he dreams of culinary school.




